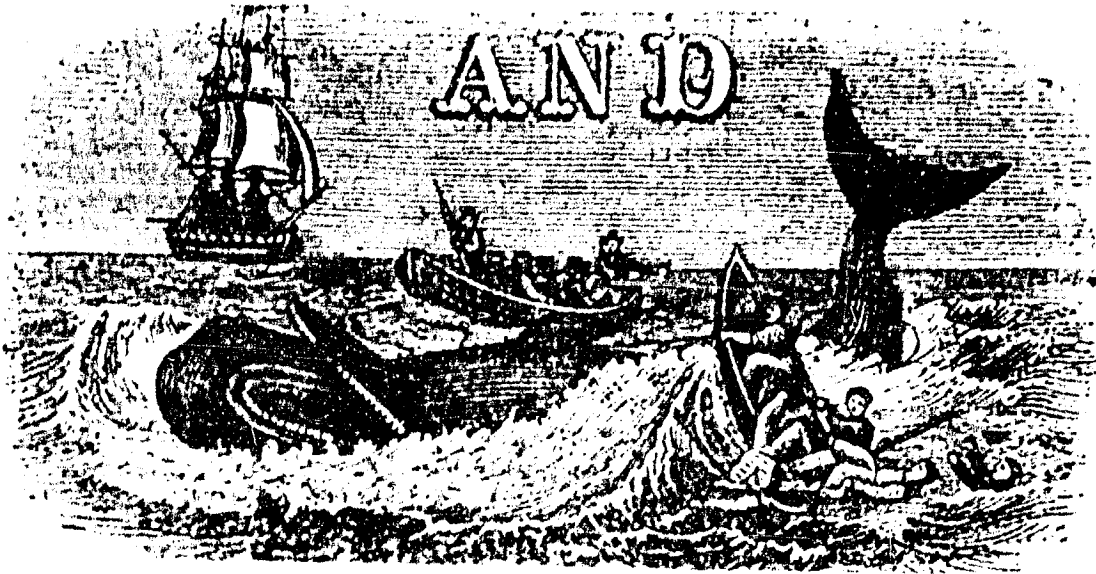

We have been politely favored with a letter from the second mate of the ship Hope of this port, giving an account of the mutiny on board ship Sharon, of Fairhaven. The following is an extract:

"The Sharon had lost eleven of her men at Ocean and Ascension Islands, and had taken some natives on board in place of them; but they did not prove good men, and Capt Norris intended to go to Port Jackson for others.

"Some days after, (no dates given) whales were raised, when the boats were lowered in pursuit, leaving Capt Norris, a boy, and three natives on board to keep ship. A whale was struck and killed, and the boats had gone in pursuit of others, when the signals of the ship were discovered to be set at half mast. The boats immediately made for the ship, and on approaching her learned from the boy, who was aloft, that the natives had murdered the captain. Attempts were made by the boat's crews to board the ship, but they were repelled by the natives who had armed themselves with cutting spades. The ship in the meantime had been got before the wind, and the boats had great difficulty in keeping up with her. The boy, who still continued aloft, was ordered by the mate to cut away the halyards of the topsails, jib, &c., and to cut the topsails clear of the yards, which he did by passing from one mast to the other on the stays; and in the evening, the boats came up to the ship, when the second mate, giving his crew instructions to board the ship when they heard the report of a musket, got overboard and swam to her, and climbing up the rudder succeeded in getting into the cabin through the window.—He then loaded some muskets, and was arming himself, when one of the natives came down, armed with a cutlass. A severe contest ensued, and the native getting the worst ran upon deck, when another came down whom the second mate shot dead. At the report of the musket, the boat's crew rushed on board, and found one of the natives armed with a cutlass and knife, who, making

resistance was shot. The other concealed himself and was not found until the next day, when he was put in irons, and carried into Sydney, where the Sharon arrived in January last.—[Mercury.

Brig Sea Bird, of Newport, at Rio Janeiro May 7, put in for men. Mr John Bryer, of Newport 2d mate, and boat's crew, left the brig when 54 ds out, three hundred miles from land, with six days provisions. The captain's boat at the time was down in pursuit of whales.

Died on board ship Huntress, of this port, Nov 8, 1842, Wm Wesson, carpenter.

Lost from on board the bark Harvest, of Fairhaven, on the passage out, Joseph Severance, of this town, who fell from aloft and was drowned.
